- 1. Technical Assessment of an Existing Aid Information Management System.** This technical mission is designed to assess the status of an existing aid information management system. The assessment will cover the extent to which the system meets user requirements and expectations. It will analyze the opportunities and risks associated with the current status of aid management and make recommendations for improving the system.
- 2. Technical Support to Upgrade an Existing Aid Information Management System.** This technical support is to upgrade an existing AIMS to meet country-specific requirements. This may involve the addition of new features or upgrading from one system to another. This technical support will begin with an assessment of the current status of the existing AIMS and recommendations for strengthening the system.
- 3. Aid Information Management System Dashboard.** This technical service is to develop a web-based AIMS dashboard to meet country-specific requirements. The objective of this activity is to create a simple, powerful reporting tool for dissemination of aid flow data to senior level stakeholders.
- 4. Aid Information Management System Interface with the National Budget and Public-Sector Financial Management System.** This technical service is to create a data exchange linkage between the AIMS and the national systems for budget and financial management. This technical service will begin with an assessment of the key programme and financial indicators available from relevant public sector financial systems.
- 5. Aid Information Management System Interface with National Development Monitoring Systems.** This technical mission is designed to build interfaces between the national AIMS and all related national monitoring systems. This is to ensure that AIMS supports the processes behind monitoring national development priorities in a harmonized, integrated framework.
- 6. Aid Information Management System e-Forum.** This discussion forum will be designed to encourage knowledge sharing and discussion regarding country-specific issues related to aid coordination and management. This technical service will establish the e-Forum and transfer the capability to a government team to operate and maintain it. The forum will be customized to meet country-specific requirements.
- 7. Aid Information Management System Administration Training and Certification.** This technical training is to build national capacity in all technical aspects of customization, setup, installation, operation, maintenance of the DevInfo Aid Information Management module.
- 8. Aid Information Management System Advanced Database and Webmaster Training and Certification.** This advanced technical training is designed to strengthen the capacity of national AIMS technicians to execute advanced database management functions and to operate and maintain related web services.
- 9. Aid Information Management System e-Learning Courseware.** This technical service is to design and develop e-learning courseware for country-specific AIMS topics. This courseware will be developed using proven instructional design techniques and industry standards (SCORM-compliant lessons).
- 10. Aid Information Management System Web Hosting Services.** This technical service is to provide a low-cost, reliable option for countries to host their aid information management system at the DevInfo lab. This technical service will include secure options for national technicians to remotely manage their AIMS.



DevInfo is a database management system which helps to monitor human development, including progress toward the Millennium Development Goals. It generates tables, graphs and maps for reports and presentations. DevInfo has been developed in cooperation within the United Nations system and has been adapted from UNICEF ChildInfo technology. 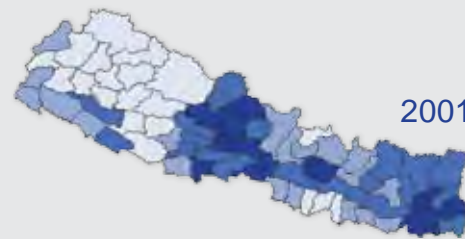
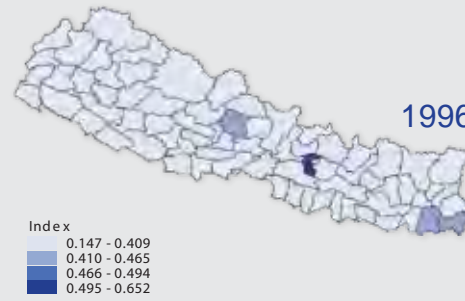
Features

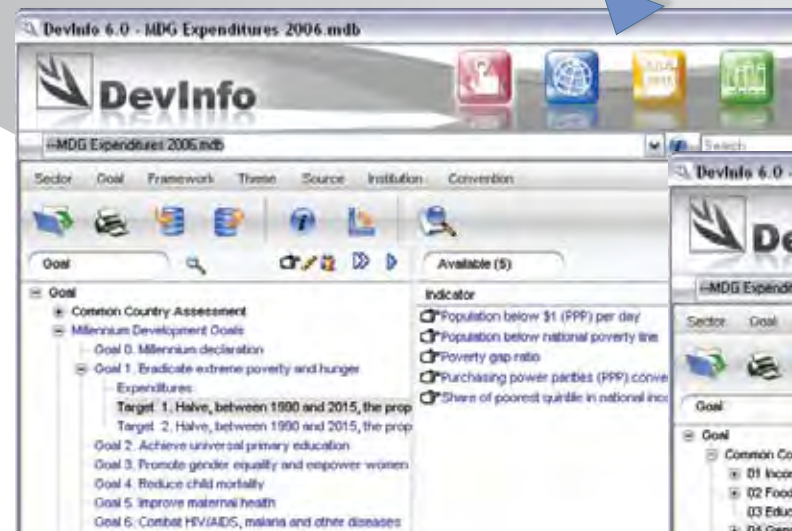

Monitoring Paris Declaration Indicators

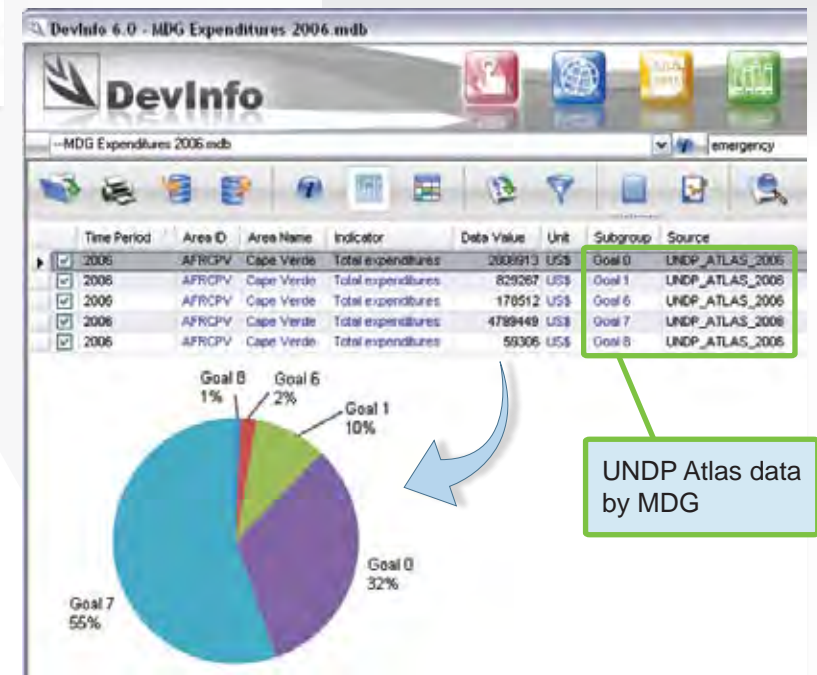
