



DevInfo Featured at Australian Statistical Meeting (April 2010)

The DevInfo database system was featured at a Statistical Leadership Seminar organized by Australia's National Statistical Service (NSS) in Canberra on 1 February 2010. The NSS is the community of government agencies led by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) tasked with building a rich statistical picture for a better informed Australia.

Nicolas Pron, DevInfo Global Administrator, UNICEF, and Kris Oswalt, Executive Director, DevInfo Support Group, delivered comprehensive presentations explaining how the DevInfo database system is being used to monitor and track human development progress across the globe. In particular, they highlighted how countries and agencies are using DevInfo as a user-friendly tool to bring statistical data at the national and sub-national levels to the forefront of evidence-based decision making processes. Additionally, they presented new ground-breaking data visualization methods built on DevInfo database technology, which powerfully demonstrate progress being made in fulfilling human development rights.
