The DevInfo website at www.devinfo.org has recently been upgraded to reflect two new Web 2.0 enhancements of great benefit to users worldwide: the addition of an Auto-Suggest feature on di Gallery and the integration of a social media bookmarking widget.

The global searchable online gallery at di Gallery has recently been enhanced with the addition of a new Auto-Suggest feature. Based on keywords entered, some of the most popular searches will be automatically displayed in a menu for user convenience.

To use this new feature to explore our well-stocked gallery of tables, graphs and maps, click the Gallery button from the home page of www.devinfo.org and go to the searchable online gallery. As keywords are entered in the search box, the Auto-Suggest menu will automatically appear.

Additionally, the DevInfo website has now integrated a new social media bookmarking widget on each page of the site. With this widget, users can easily share interesting human development stories with friends, fans and followers by simply clicking the icon of their preferred social networking service, such as Twitter or Facebook.
